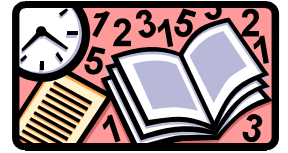

## SUMMER READING, WRITING, AND MATH 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR INCOMING GRADE 3

**READ 1 BOOK IN EACH OF THE TWO CATEGORIES AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR THE BOOK REPORT. THE PROJECTS ARE DUE ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2010, THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.**

**1. FICTION BOOK** Read a fiction book of your choice. Create a book cover that includes the title, author, and an illustration of your favorite scene from the book. On the back of your cover, write your name and 3 to 5 sentences that describe the book.

**2. NON-FICTION BOOK** Read a non-fiction book of your choice. Write a letter to the main character inviting him or her to dinner at your house. Tell the main character why you would like to meet him or her and why you admire that person. Be sure to sign your name to your letter.

Students should read books that are on or above their grade level.

### BOOK LOG

Each child is encouraged to read beyond the requirements to maintain reading skills throughout the summer. For each additional book read, complete the Book Log form with the title of the book, its author, the date it was read, and a parent signature. The Book Log must be handed in on the first day of school in order to receive the sneaker passes.

As an incentive to read during the summer, students who read more than the two required books will receive a *Sneaker Pass* for every 5 books read (up to 5 sneaker passes).
